Here's what to expect in class: We'll begin at 9:00 AM with a short presentation that introduces key concepts and situations you're likely to encounter as you continue your bonsai journey.

After that, you'll start working on your tree—or multiple trees, if you choose. Time permitting, we'll work through as many as we can.



## GUIDANCE

I'll rotate among students, offering one-on-one guidance while others continue working on the tasks we discussed during their turn.

At times, I may pause the class to highlight a technique or issue on someone else's tree.

This shared learning approach helps everyone progress more quickly by observing a variety of examples.





We'll all take a break together for lunch. I'll provide the main meal—feel free to bring something to share if you'd like! My lunches are usually simple; previous lunches have been hot dogs, chips, and potato salad.

In the morning, I'll have donuts and coffee available.

The rest of the day will be all about immersing ourselves in the art of bonsai.

We'll wrap up the day with a personalized outline or plan for your trees, giving you a clear direction for the year ahead. You'll also gain a better understanding of how to make the most of the club's resources.

The Dig In is a one-time class, while the Chop In class can be ongoing—designed to support you until you feel confident and ready to move up to the next level.
